



(1) Seeing the Long and Short Vowel




(3) 'j' is slanted to remind learners of




(5) Numerals Tone Markers Indicating Pitch

(4) Thinner glyphs for 'z' and 'c' to highlight pronunciation after vowels 'aa', 'a', 'i' and 'e'









Darker Initials vs Finals






(3) Visualise pitch height and pitch contour for better pronunciation control

Installation Guide for MS Office



- 1. Open LS Yale/LS Jyutping.ttf and click 'Install'.
 - *Please ignore any error messages that appeared during installation.
- 2. Open a blank MS Word document with its default font setting.
- 3. Right click, select 'Font', then select 'Advanced'.
- 4. Select 'Use Contextual Alternatives' then click 'OK'.



- 5. Select 'LS Yale /LS Jyutping' font and use.
- The current version of LS Yale/LS Jyutping are not available for MS Office 365.
- Should you have any suggestions for the development of the fonts, please contact us.

User Reminder for LS Yale

Normally, Yale romanisation is written without a space between syllables but this may cause display issues with the font. To solve the issue, please insert a dash '-' or space between syllables.

Sintā can be interpreted as Sintā 蝕吖or Sin-tā 是他. The font cannot determine where to divide the words sometimes, and that part needs to be done manually by the user.
